# Make Plans to Join Us For Bible Study!

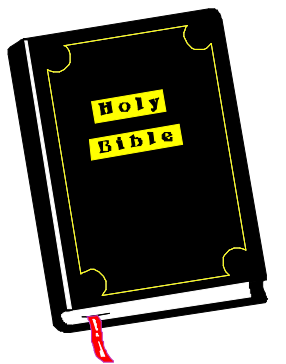

## Cross Ministry

Our Cross Ministry offers each of us a way to share our faith with friends, neighbors, and strangers. Simple metal crosses are available for us to keep on our person and share with others anytime opportunities present themselves. "God Loves You" appearing on each cross will be a constant reminder of His loving presence in our lives.

We are asking that you do two things: (1) Keep one cross in your pocket or purse at all times; (2) Look for opportunities to give away crosses as a gift to another person. A cross could be included in a card or letter, as part of a tip in a restaurant, given as an encouragement to someone, or even shared with an anonymous person who may pick it up from a vending machine coin return or off the ground.

You do not need to say anything, but if you wish, you might say, "I want you to have this." You could add, "If you know what it means, pass it on to someone else; if you don't, hang on to it until your life is changed.

Begin now to plan other creative ways to share your crosses and your faith with those around you.

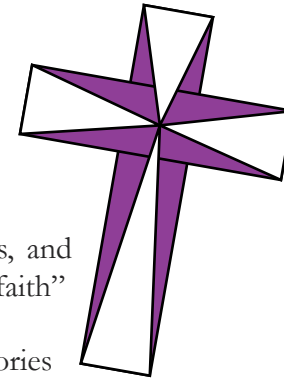
### In a Nutshell...

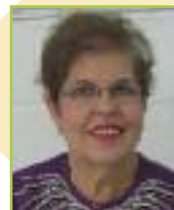

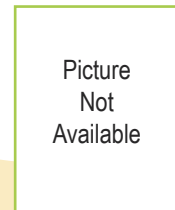

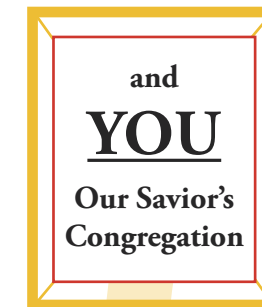
## Prayer Vigils
